Accreditation

The American College of Greece is accredited by The New England Commission on Higher Education (NECHE) and its degree programs are validated by The Open University (OU) in the United Kingdom.

Credit System

Most courses are 3 credits. Science courses that include lab hours carry 4 credits, and some courses carry 1 or 2 credits. Students may register for up to 15 credits in the fall or spring semester and up to 6 credits in each summer session.
